Dates and Times

Friday 1st to Sunday 3rd May 2026. Arrival is from 4.00pm on Friday, and departure by 3pm on Sunday (after lunch)

Venue

The Tops Conference Centre, 51 Bendena Gardens, Stanwell Tops NSW 2508

Cost

\$590.00 AUD per person. This includes workshops, meals and accommodation.

Workshops will run from Friday evening, Saturday morning, Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning. We are planning a presentation/information session for Saturday evening.

Meals include dinner served at 6pm on Friday and Saturday nights, and breakfast/lunch on Saturday and Sunday. Morning and afternoon teas and supper are also provided.

Accommodation is all on ground level, using only lower bunks in shared rooms with a bathroom. A light doona and pillow are provided. Bedding and towels are **not** supplied, so you will need to bring a pillowcase, sleeping bag or equivalent bedding. Wifi is available across the venue.

Arrival and Departure

The nearest **train** station is Helensburgh Station, which is then a 15 minute car/taxi drive to the venue.

For those coming by **car**, there is plenty of parking space on site.

Check in on arrival Friday is **from 4pm** (no earlier!) until 5.30pm. Our accommodation will only be accessible **from 5pm**. A lounge room is available for those arriving between 4pm and 5pm.

The Camp will wrap up after Sunday lunch, and everyone must leave the venue by 3pm. Please consider this when organising transport.

Workshop Requirements

Spinning wheel – Attendees must provide their own (functioning!) spinning wheel. This **does not** need to be a Majacraft wheel, but you should be competent at using it.

Materials – Blending boards and fibre will be supplied for workshops. We will advise you of any small additions or optional extras.

Registration and Payment

All bookings are to be made by returning the attached Registration Form to Virginia Farm Wool Works via email. Payment by direct bank deposit is required to secure your booking. Bookings will close when maximum numbers are reached.

You can select to either pay the full price (\$590 AUD) upon registration, or in two instalments (\$200 and \$390 AUD). If choosing instalments, payments are due as follows:

- Payment #1 – \$200 due upon registration
- Payment #2 – \$390 due by 15th February 2026

If you select this option, we will send a reminder to submit your final payment. Failure to pay by the final due date may result in losing your place at the Camp.

Refund Policy

We can provide a full refund (minus a \$50 admin fee) up to 28th February 2026. After this date, a refund is dependent on your place being taken by another participant.
